Thank you for your request of 29 September 2025 seeking the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

*"...what advice the commission has provided to the minister on the issue of whether its specific advice on emissions reduction plans is still necessary, which the minister has said is under consideration ...*

*...any and all information the commission holds on the advice it has provided the minister on that particular issue over the last 12 months. Please note we (and as I'm sure you are aware, the Official Information Act) do not distinguish between "formal" advice and any other type of advice (it is all advice); and this request does include any recollections of verbal advice as well as any documented advice such as emails, meeting notes, etc."*

The Commission has considered your request in accordance with the Act, and we can respond as follows.

#### Response

The Commission has not provided any advice to the Minister of Climate Change on *"whether its specific advice on emissions reduction plans is still necessary"*.



On this basis, we rely on section 18(g) of the Act in not providing you with the information you seek, as this information is not held by the Commission.
