On 5 October 2021, the Minister for Climate Change transferred the following part of your Official Information Act (OIA) request to the Climate Change Commission:

“May I have meeting minutes from any meeting the climate minister has had with Ngāi Tahu and Ngāti Waewae, the Climate Commission and Commissioners and West Coast Council and Mayors regarding a just transition away from coal?”

This response addresses your request for information relating to meetings held with the Commission and Hon James Shaw, Minister for Climate Change. The Commission’s Chair, Dr Rodd Carr, and Chief Executive, Jo Hendy, meet regularly with Hon Shaw to discuss a range of topics. I can advise that the Commission holds no minutes from these meetings.
