Thank you for your email of 8 March 2022 requesting under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

I request under the Official Information Act 1982, the following:

- *Any correspondence between the Climate Commission and the Treasury regarding the Emissions Trading Scheme or He Waka Eke Noa*
- *Any information held by the Climate Commission regarding the potential economic impact of bringing agriculture in the Emissions Trading Scheme.*
- *Any information held by the Climate Commission regarding the potential economic impact of He Waka Eke Noa and the options proposed under it.*

Regarding the first part of your request, we understand that Treasury have responded to this, as you made a similar request to them. We will respond to the second and third parts of your request.

As noted in our extension letter of 8 April 2022, there is a large volume of material in scope of your request, which also requires substantial consultation to be undertaken ahead of release, and the Commission is still working through this. We will endeavour to send you the information by 10 July 2022 or as soon as practicable.

You have the right to seek an investigation and review by the Office of the Ombudsman of this decision, in accordance with section 28(3) of the Official Information Act 1982. The relevant details can be found on their website at: www.ombudsman.parliament.nz
